## Fast-Track Application Form

Information for undergraduate students applying to the Fast-Track Program:

- This form is used for one-time application to *Fast-Track* Program.
- Requirements to enroll in the *Fast-Track* Program leading to a masters' degree are determined by each program/department in conjunction with the Office of Graduate Studies. Admission criteria and other details are available from the Office of Undergraduate Advising.
- Undergraduates have three options for registering for graduate courses:

Option #A	<b>Undergraduate degree ONLY</b> (maximum of 12 hours allowed)
Option #B	<b>Fast-Track Option</b> (maximum of 15 hours allowed)
Option #C	<b>Graduate degree ONLY</b> (maximum of 12 hours allowed)

- **Option A** can be used by qualified undergraduate (90 SCH + GPA) with permission of the undergraduate advisor and the graduate course instructor.
- **Options B** students must designate coursework after the admission into *Fast-Track* program. ***The designation can NOT be changed after a student's undergraduate degree has been certified.*** The default designation is undergraduate degree only.
- **Option C** must be designated prior to enrolling a graduate course and can NOT be changed. To register for a course as option C, student must go to the Student Services Building (SSB) and complete registration.
- All coursework must apply to either a student's undergraduate or approved *Fast-Track* graduate degree program.
- *Fast-Track* courses can only be applied to Master's degree programs (no certificate programs).
- *Fast-Track* courses must be graded courses (no CR/NC or P/F courses are allowed).
- *Fast-Track* courses can only be preapproved 5000/6000 level courses.
- **Application Deadlines:**
  - For spring semester entry: October 21 of previous year
  - For summer and fall semester entry: March 21 of that year
